








McCloud River Mercantile Co: After you've explored Mount Shasta, head to McCloud and enjoy shopping and dining in a historic restored Mercantile. With numerous merchants offering a variety of goods, you'll find everything from an apothecary candy store, handmade jewelry, apparel, and vintage goods.

McCloud Falls: After you've had lunch, head on over to McCloud Falls. There are actually three levels to McCloud Falls: lower, middle and upper, each offering different views. Hiking to each of the falls is relatively easy - each fall is accessible by car and a short walk to the vista point, and there is a path that leads to all three if you feel like a hike.





Hedge Creek Falls: Not ready to stop looking at waterfalls just yet? Then head over to Hedge Creek Falls. Take a winding, serene path, leading to the beautiful waterfall. There's even a little cave behind the falls where you can look through the falls and into the beautiful forest.

Railroad Park Resort: Finish your day off with dinner at Railroad Park Resort! The Dining Car Restaurant is one of the most interesting restaurants in Dunsmuir, CA.
